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Benefit Design Key Opportunities to Leverage Evidence




- The elimination of the medically homeless





SMOKING & ACUTE ILLNESS LEADS TO CHRONIC & CATASTROPHIC ILLNESS







Necessary elements to base benefits on value

Evidence-based medicine

best science with consideration to personal ethics and desires as well as coverage
Right treatment at the right place at the right time
Effective guidance: Directed vs self-directed



Primary Care Considerations

- Traditional vs Advanced
- Guidance and navigation by intention
- Accountability
 - To whom? For what?
- Accessibility
- Measurability
- Clearing obstacles
- Payment model



Challenges

- A true understanding of your own population's health/risk/needs
- Is your primary care
 - Quick/cheap/attractive/good enough?
- New drivers of healthcare...and the digital medical home?
- The twentysomething: family doc vs untested models
- If value=(quality/cost), how to determine quality and cost?
- Separate tool for every problem with no coordination (the ROI promise)

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Value Based Insurance Design (VBID): Practical considerations

- Eliminate or decrease member cost sharing for high value services
 - Preventive services
 - Cancer screening tests
 - Preventive medications
 - Annual examinations
 - Primary care physician visits
 - Medications for chronic illnesses
- Increase member cost sharing (or eliminate coverage) for low value services
 - Few services are always of low value (e.G., Vit. D testing, tonsillectomy)
- Fairness?
- Discriminatory?

Accept the fact that it will not be perfect and might generate some noise.
